

**BIG IDEA:** Jesus is relevant.

## SUMMARY

Hope is here in 2020 because Jesus is here in 2020. Jesus is the same yesterday, today, and tomorrow. It's easy to lose sight that Jesus is more than enough and think church is part of a routine or religion. But if we make Jesus our vision for the first year of the decade it sets the tone for the next ten years. A vision is what captures your heart, it's something you want more than anything else, and it keeps you from drifting.

## KEY POINTS

### 1. YOU ARE JESUS' VISION

- "You captured His heart; He wants you more than anything else." (Luke 19:10)
- "If Jesus isn't your vision then you've lost sight that you are His vision."
- "At the beginning of the year we need our faith to not be in what we have to do but in what He's already done." (Romans 10:17)
- "Grace strengthens, restores, and supernaturally changes you." (Acts 20:32)

*What do you think your life would look like if you actually believed Jesus' vision was you?*

### 2. THE SERMON ON THE MOUNT

- "We were born with leprosy of the soul."
- "Our part in the salvation equation is humility and desperation." (Psalm 51:17, 1 John 1:9)
- "The greatest barrier between you and God is not sin, it's your pride." (Matthew 9:12-13)
- "Jesus has compassion, He is willing, and He is able." (Mark 1:40-41, Acts 4:12)
- "You never have to question whether or not He's willing, because you are His vision." (Isaiah 53:5)
- "Let's stop covering up what has already been cleansed, stop compensating for what He has taken care of, and receive salvation."

*Where are you desperate for a fresh touch from Jesus in your life?*

### 3. SALVATION IS SOZO – TO SAVE, HEAL, MAKE WHOLE, DELIVER

- "You have the keys to the Kingdom, and you hear the voice of God."
- "When you put your faith in Jesus you are saved."
- "Grace isn't about eternal life someday, it's about abundant life today."
- "We don't just need Him in our past, we need Him in our present."
- "Jesus sees your misery, hears your cries, and is concerned about your suffering." (Matthew 9:36)

*Where is God calling you to live abundantly today?*

### 4. IN JESUS YOU HAVE BEEN SAVED, YOU ARE BEING SAVED, AND YOU WILL BE SAVED

- "If He's more than enough, we know we are saved when we change. (2 Corinthians 5:17)
- "In Jesus your identity is restored, your relationships are reconciled, and you have a redeemed purpose."
- "We live an inferior life because we don't think we need His saving grace today." (2 Corinthians 6:2)
- "His grace forgives you from sin, empowers you to have victory over sin, and will free you from the presence of sin." (Luke 17:15-16)

*In Jesus, what in your life has changed?*
