# DISCUSSION GUIDE

BIG IDEA: Jesus is relevant.

#### SUMMARY

In this series, we are turning our hearts, affection, and attention to Jesus; focusing on who He is and what He has done. The world does not believe that He is more than enough **(1 Corinthians 1:18)**. It's easy for us to get lost in our accomplishments, relationships, and goals, but Jesus is more than enough for every area of our lives. Jesus is passionate for us and relentlessly pursues us. The things we passionately pursue, we see value in. Knowing that God's passion for us goes beyond all understanding in the fact that He sacrificed His Son Jesus for us, helps us understand the passion and desperation for Jesus we are to have. Being desperate and humble for Jesus allows us to experience all He has for us. We are to be relentless in our pursuit of Jesus.

# PASSIONATE PURSUIT

- "We relentlessly pursue that which we think is valuable." (Mark 5:28)
- "God sacrificed everything and created time for you."
- "If I can just grab hold of His grace I will be satisfied, healed, made whole." (Numbers 15:38-39)
- "Humble people experience the grace of God; prideful people watch God walk in and out." (James 4:6)
- "If you want to break the barrier and go to a place you've never been, you're going to have to reach out to Jesus in a way you never have."

- "We don't add things to Jesus, we add Jesus to our things—this is where we get stuck."
- "Jesus loves you enough to challenge you."
- "Jesus either offends or transforms you." (Exodus 20:3)
- "An idol is anything in your life that has more power than Jesus."
- "Seek Jesus first and He'll give you the rest." (Matthew 6:33)
- "If you want a satisfied soul then hunger and thirst for Jesus." (Matthew 5:6) (John 6:35)
- "Jesus is our Righteousness." (Jeremiah 23:6)
- "Jesus is the desire of all the nations."

Where are you trying to add Jesus to your life versus letting Jesus be your life?
