We stop believing that God is good and that everything is possible.

We have to have an eternal perspective. We have got to have faith that more of the kingdom of God isin these days.
There is a huge difference between fact and truth. Fact is what you can; truth is what God has
Fact is there are giants in your life. Truth is they've already been in Jesus' name.
Therefore God exalted him to the highest place and gave him the name that is above every name, that at the name of Jesus, every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord. Philippians 2:9-11
I love our theology. I love what we believe about Jesus and how we're focusing on that.
The story of David and Goliath is not about you. You're not David. Jesus is David. You are the army, that every day wakes up and can't defeat its giant and turns around and runs away.
Jesus, the good shepherd, showed up when no one else could defeat Goliath. Jesus, the good shepherd, went into the valley of the shadow of death on our behalf.
Jesus wanted us to see that Satan has been fully defeated and that cutting off his head means he has no more voice ofin your life.
