## DISCUSS & ENGAGE THE SCRIPTURES

- 1. How did this message increase your perspective of the awe and wonder of God?
- 2. Read <u>Exodus 33:19,34:5-7</u> and <u>John 1:1-4,14</u>. The name of God (YAHWEH), the great I AM/HE IS, contains the personhood, power, and presence of God. In His name are all the realities of God.
  - What does this mean to you?
- 3. Read <u>Exodus 20:4-5</u> and <u>Hebrews 3:1</u>. Idols (lowercase "g" gods) are anything that have our worship (attention, affection, and emotion).
  - Is there any area of your heart or mind where you're aligning your attention, affection, and emotion with both Jesus <u>and</u> other gods (elohim)? If so, how will you move forward in repentance (<u>Romans 2:4</u>)?
- 4. Read John 8:58 and John 17:6 AMPC. As you read through these declarations of Jesus, what is the Holy Spirit saying to you? How are they causing you to think differently about God's goodness?
  - I AM the bread of life
  - I AM the light of the world
  - I AM the good shepherd
  - I AM the resurrection and the life
  - I AM the way, the truth, and the life
  - I AM the vine
