

DISCUSS & ENGAGE THE SCRIPTURES

- 1. The Bible is God's voice; it's not a book. How does this change your perspective of engaging God's Word?
- 2. Read <u>Psalms 119:160</u>. God's Word shows us three things:
 - a. What is true in a world full of lies. Read <u>Matthew 7:24-27</u>. What is the Holy Spirit saying to you about your source of truth? What are some lies you've believed that have influenced your daily life?
 - b. What is possible in a world of impossibilities. Read <u>Isaiah 55:8-9</u>. In what areas of life have you resisted dreaming with God? Why do you think you've been resisting?
 - God's heart in a world without heart. Read <u>Matthew 12:34-35</u> and <u>Jeremiah 15:16</u>. God's heart is good, so His Word can only be good. What is your heart hungry for?
- Read <u>Matthew 4:4</u>. God's Word is simply God speaking. His Word *creates* (<u>Genesis 1:3-4 NLT</u>), *sustains* (<u>Hebrews 1:3</u>), and *redeems* (<u>Revelation 19:11,15</u>) all things. How do you see Him creating, sustaining, and redeeming your life?
