1. Read [Jeremiah 33:3](#). As you reflect on whether or not you believe the best is yet to come, which camp do you resonate with the most and how so?

 - Camp #2: This is as good as it gets. (Stuck in the circumstances of life)

 - What's holding you back from God's best for your life? ([Judges 6:7-10](#))
