### Membership Subs


Membership subs are now *overdue*. These new rates reflect the increases from the BMC:

Malcolm was only 29 when he fell from a scramble in Ogwen in August 1989. He was a good club member, a regular on coach meets and socials, as well as an accomplished rock climber and runner. He was on the committee as Hut Secretary at the time and his accident had a massive impact on the club.

After meeting with his parents it was decided to commence a memorial in the form of an annual award covering either services to the club or outstanding mountaineering achievement. This is presented at the AGM with nominations coming from any club member. It can be for recognition of mountaineering achievement or contribution to the club.

The Club have managed to secure the Eskdale Centre bunkhouse for the 17<sup>th</sup> to 19<sup>th</sup> of April. It sleeps 24 in configurations 2, 2, 8 and 10 (snoring options and split sexes will be planned) with a large communal area and kitchen.

Two of the five pubs in the valley, The Boot Inn and Brookhouse Inn are 395 and 428 yards from the Bunkhouse, with a pub crawl to all five being a very viable option. It is the first time, to my knowledge, that the club has based in Eskdale, which serves as a gateway into the less frequented Eskdale fells and hard knot pass area, as well as Nether Wasdale only a 20 min drive away, offering wide opportunities for many varied activities from quiet riverside ambles and low level fells to England's highest mountain Scafell via a 'back' route.

## Suggested routes

#### FROM KIRKSTONE INN

Route 1 (~14km / 9 miles) Climb NW up the steep slope to Red Screes (396087). Continue NW first descending into Scandale Pass then climb again (following a wall) past Little Hart Crag and onto Dove Crag (375104). From here follow the ridge over Hart Crag and onto Fairfield (359117). Leave the summit N and descend via the sharp peak of Cofa Pike (358121) and St Sunday Crag (369135) down into Patterdale and a short road walk to the coach in Glenridding

#### Route 2 (~15km / 9.5 miles)

Stay on the East side of the road and follow St Ravens Edge to Stony Cove Pike (417100). Descend to Theshthwaite Mouth (taking care over finding direction if visibility is poor) and ascend Thornthwaite Crag (432101) followed by High Street (441111) Follow the ridge N to the Knott (437127) then descend past the picturesque Angle Tarn (417145) down in to Patterdale and a short road walk to the coach in Glenridding

#### Route 2b (~13.5km / 8.5 miles)

Route 2 can be shortened by proceeding to Theshthwaite Mouth then head NW down towards Patterdale via Pasture Bottom.

#### FROM PATTERDALE

Route 3 (~14km / 9 miles)

From Patterdale follow a track to where it turns right over Grisedale Beck (383157) Climb steeply to the Hole In the Wall (359155) and traverse the grade 1 ridge of Striding Edge to the summit of Helvellyn (342152) Descend via Lower Man (337155) to Whiteside Bank (338166) and then take the lower path down Glenridding Common (352166) a good track leads you past the Youth Hostel (366174) back to the coach in Glenridding.

Coach Rule 7 may apply: Do not go above the snowline without ice-axe and crampons. Should winter conditions prevail, give your route selection some careful thought. Please stow your ice-axes and crampons in the side compartment of the coach. Don't leave them in the boot where they could damage rucksacks.

### Suggested routes

FROM PONT Y GRIBLE

#### ROUTE 1 (~27km / 16.5 miles)

Follow a good track West to Graigddu - Isaf (681301) then continue West through the forest to the Roman Steps (661299) and Llyn Du (656294) before climbing steeply to the summit of Rhinog Fawr (656290. Descend East for 40m then descend a very steep gully down into the valley (660281). Follow a path East to the col then South making your own way through the heather to the summit of Rhinog Fach (665270). A good path now follows a wall over Y Llethr (661258), Diffwys (661234) and eventually Bwlch y Rhiwgyr (627200). From here descend to Sylfaen (632185) where a road leads into Barmouth and the coach.

This is a long and demanding walk – if in any doubt consider routes 2 or 4.

#### ROUTE 2 (~24km / 15 miles)

Follow a good track West to Graiigddu - Isaf (681301) then head South through the forest past Grugle (675287) to grid reference (666283) Ascend Rhinog Fach (665270) then follow Route 1 to Barmouth

#### From Llanelltyd

ROUTE 4 (~15km / 10 miles)

Follow the A470 South to the A493 road junction and cross the bridge over Afon Wnion (713183) Follow the Morfa Mawddach walk along the dismantled railway passing Penmachpool bridge (695185) Garth Isaf (653162) and Morfa Mawddach station (628142) Cross the footbridge where a small toll is to be paid at the end before finishing in Barmouth
