## HOUSE RULES



Dear visitors of the Gropius Passagen,

To ensure that you always feel comfortable with us, it is necessary to regulate certain things. Therefore, we have created these house rules. The following points apply to the entire premises of Gropius Passagen, especially the shopping street.

- 1. Smoking and vaping are generally not permitted in Gropius Passagen. Please use the designated smoking areas outside the building. For cannabis products, this ban also applies to the entire outdoor area of the Gropius Passagen, including the parking decks.
- 2. The consumption of alcoholic beverages outside of gastronomic establishments is not permitted.
- 3. Begging and soliciting, as well as unnecessary lingering, are not allowed either inside the center or in the immediate vicinity of the outdoor areas.
- 4. Selling goods, commercial film and photo recordings, making music, performances, and events are not allowed without written permission from the center management.
- 5. Distributing advertising materials, posting posters, conducting customer surveys, etc., requires written permission from the center management.
- 6. Bicycles and motorbikes may not be driven or pushed through the shopping street. Riding kickboards, roller skates, inline skates, skateboards, e-scooters, Segways, and similar vehicles, whether motorized, electric, or human-powered, is also prohibited for safety reasons. Mobility aids such as wheelchairs, walkers, and strollers are, of course, exempt from this ban.
- 7. Dogs must be kept on a leash. Dog owners must clean up any mess themselves.
- 8. Sitting is only allowed on the benches provided for this purpose, but not on the floors, stairs, or in the flowerbeds.
- 9. Willful pollution, damage, or misuse of facilities, including in common areas such as toilets, restrooms, medical rooms, etc., will result in a ban from the premises and claims for damages.
- 10. Remaining after being asked to leave the center by the center management or its representatives may be prosecuted as trespassing.
- 11. The behavior of our visitors must not hinder or disturb others. Violations may be prosecuted as trespassing.
