Congratulations to Rebekah Phillips, who was selected for the Polocrosse New Zealand Junior U16 Team and was one of three who won the U16 New Zealand Polocrosse Scholarship. This scholarship allows her to travel to Australia later this year to help develop her riding and playing skills. Her sister Lauren Phillips, was also selected in the New Zealand development squad that trialled for the Junior team, earlier this summer.



ETHAN BRYERS

Ethan Bryers had a successful swim at the recent 2019 AON NZ Age Group Championships in Wellington. He brought home the first ever boys' national title for the Toyota Whanganui Swim Club after winning gold for the 400m Freestyle event. He then went on to gain a silver medal for the 1500m Freestyle, and picked up another five top 10 placings. This places Ethan as a premier swimmer within the 14-year-old age bracket. Ethan has been selected for the Stage 2 Selection Camp for the Australian State Champs.
