CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19) UPDATE

I will keep my newsletter as succinct as possible:

- School holidays now begin from Monday 30 March to Tuesday 14 April inclusive.
- At the end of the school holidays, schools will provide distance learning but are **not physically open** for staff to work at the schools.
- The instruction to stay home (Alert Level 4) will continue beyond the new school holiday period, but schools will be technically **open for distance instruction.** Teachers will be **working offsite**.
- Many Whanganui High School teachers will have already made Google Classroom connection with your children, and email connection with you and/or your children over the last couple of days. More will make these connections and maintain effective learning relationships with your children **as Term 2 begins.**
- Our focus is on providing a range of meaningful and varied learning opportunities for your children over the coming weeks especially during the time when the school holidays have ended.
- When Term 2 begins, teachers may nominate times when they will be available online to answer emails, questions, etc please be mindful that most full-time teachers have five or six classes and many teachers already have their own children to look after during this pandemic.
