

Maripi Tuatini is about putting foundations in place for future leadership. Cultural training and knowledge that is specific to Ngā Wairiki and Ngāti Apa is taught, as well as general social, financial and environmental experiences and skills to further student's potential. Another focus is support and encouragement for participants to succeed in education. The programme is delivered over 5 years for one week of each school holiday including specific marae and haapu engagement and Iwi events each term.
