## WHANGANUI HIGH SCHOOL REPRESENTATIVE POLICY 2022

Representing Whanganui High School in co-curricular or extra-curricular activities during a timetabled school day or timetabled school week; attending the School Ball; achieving the Year 13 Diploma.

1. Representing Whanganui High School in co-curricular or extra-curricular activities during a normal timetabled day or school week (All year levels – Years 9 to 13)

Such activities include (but are not limited to) the following teams and groups: Sport teams; Kia Whaiora; Shakespeare Festival team; Pasifika group; Duke of Edinburgh groups; Musical performance groups; Speech competition groups; Junior and Senior Production casts and crew; Debating groups; World Vision groups; Chess teams; Awa Side Choir.

- Students must have <u>fewer than 5% (five percent) Unjustified Absences</u> (including Form Time and all subject classes) to represent Whanganui High School during a normal timetabled school day or school week.
- Any associated costs must be paid prior to the event, or payment arrangements made with the Bursar's Office before the event begins.
- 2. Attending the School Ball (Year 12 and Year 13 students)
  - Students must have <u>fewer than 5% (five percent) Unjustified Absences</u> (including Form Time and all subject classes) to attend the School ball.
- 3. Achieving the Year 13 Diploma
  - Year 13 students must have <u>fewer than 5% (five percent) Unjustified Absences</u> (including Form Time and all subject classes) to achieve the Year 13 Diploma.
  - Year 13 students must have a good record of work completion in all subject areas.

Any questions related to this document are to be referred to the Principal. The final decision regarding representation, attendance at the School Ball and the Year 13 Diploma will be made by the Principal.
