Industrial Action – PPTA Union Nationwide Teachers’ Strike on Wednesday, 29 March

The PPTA Union has advised the Boards of all Secondary Schools throughout New Zealand that its member teachers will be taking strike action on Wednesday, 29 March 2023.

Whanganui High School cannot provide normal instruction and staffing during the strike so the school will officially be closed for instruction on 29 March. We can, however, provide some staff supervision for students under 14 years of age by teachers who are not members of the PPTA Union.
