PPTA Union Nationwide Industrial Action

The PPTA Union has advised the Principals and Boards of all Secondary Schools throughout New Zealand that PPTA member teachers will be taking strike action over the next few weeks of this term.

At this stage, I will outline the notice of strike action for the teaching or supervising of various year levels by PPTA members over the next <u>two weeks</u>.

I will send an updated newsletter if the situation changes at all.

Week 2

Thursday, 4 May – Year 11 students to stay at home; all other Year levels to be at school.

Week 3

Tuesday, 9 May – Year 12 students to stay at home; all other Year levels to be at school.

Thursday, 11 May – Year 13 students to stay at home; all other Year levels to be at school.

Rolling one-day PPTA Union national strikes across all regions are presently set for <u>Week 3</u>. All Whanganui-Manawatu, Taranaki, Hawkes Bay, Wellington, Hutt Valley PPTA member teachers are set to strike all day on <u>Wednesday</u>, <u>10 May</u>.
