Personal presentation and our school LIFE values

Please also note that students wearing non-uniform items will always have those items confiscated by staff members - such items are then collected by students from the Deans' House after school on Friday afternoons and kept at home. All students are also expected to be clean-shaven at school - we provide quality single-use disposable razors and smooth shaving cream in the Student Centre for those students who have arrived at school noticeably unshaven.
