Attendance

On 5 July, every family received a summary percentage figure of their teenager's attendance at Whanganui High School up until the end of Term 2, along with relevant supporting information.

From 6.00 pm every Friday evening from this week onwards, we will be emailing a weekly attendance update to every family regarding your teenager's attendance. The Attendance Summary will show:

- 1. Attendance to every timetabled class for the current week.
- 2. The Attendance percentage figure for the year up to the current point in time (including Justified Absences and Unjustified Absences).
- 3. Attendance percentage figures for each Subject and Form Time (FT) up to the current point in time.
- 4. Any Pastoral Incidents (Discipline and Classroom) for the current week (if there are any pastoral incidents to show).

Please remember that the key Ministry of Education guidelines for attendance are:

- Regular Attendance (attending more than 90%)
- Irregular Attendance (attending than 80% and up to 90%)
- Moderate Absence (attending more than 70% and up to 80%)
- Chronic Absence (attending 70% or less)
