Please note that the Uniform Sets below cannot be used interchangeably, for example, students cannot mix-and-match uniform items from one Set with uniform items from another Set at the same time.

Please also note, however, that students and families may choose to stay with one Uniform Set only throughout the entire year in order to reduce uniform costs; **OR** students and families may choose to move from one Set to another Set throughout the different cooler and warmer weather seasons. The choice sits completely with each individual student and family.

Uniform Set 1

Skirt	Year 9 - 11 - Grey straight skirt with front knife pleats and side pocket, worn on the knee. Year 12 & 13 - Black skirt worn on the knee; Grey skirt worn on the knee (optional).
Shirt	White polo shirt with school crest, or, regulation tailored white short sleeved shirt.
Footwear	Plain flat black sandals with heel strap (Roman type), or plain black leather traditional style school shoes.
Socks	White ankle socks (only worn with shoes).
Jersey	Green woollen 'V' necked jersey with school crest
Sweater	Green crew neck sweater with school crest.

Uniform Set 2

Skirt	Tartan skirt worn below the knee.
Shirt	Long-sleeved white shirt worn tucked in.
Trousers	Regulation black trousers (optional).
Tie	School tie (optional).
Jersey	Green woollen 'V' necked jersey with school crest.
Sweater	Green crew neck sweater with school crest.
Footwear	Plain black flat leather traditional style school shoes.
Tights	Black.
Socks	Black plain socks.

Uniform Set 3

Trousers	Regulation black trousers (with front creases). Must be worn with white long sleeved shirt tucked in.
Tie	School tie (optional)
Shorts	Year 9 - 11 - Grey shorts with self-supporting top. Year 12 & 13 – Regulation black shorts.
Shirt	White polo shirt with school crest, with shorts; or white long-sleeved shirt (tucked in) with black trousers.
Footwear	Plain black sandals with heel strap (Roman style), or plain black leather traditional style school shoes.
Socks	Grey socks with Whanganui High School colours around the top, with shorts; or black socks with trousers.
Jersey	Green woollen 'V' necked jersey with school crest.
Sweater	Green crew neck sweater with school crest.

Jacket / Rainwear	Regulation waterproof rain jacket with WHS Crest. Plain black jacket.
Scarf/ Gloves	Black or WHS green (optional).
Sunhat	WHS green bucket hat (available from the Student Centre)

Personal Presentation Requirements

We have a great deal of pride in our school uniform and in the strength of our school identity within our wider community. We expect all students and family members to work in partnership with the school to ensure consistently high levels of uniform and personal presentation standards.

- **Hoodies** are not part of our school uniform. Sports hoodies, team hoodies and any hoodies at all must be worn outside of school and not at school during the normal school day.
- **Covered shoes** must be worn when students are requested to do so by teachers in Science and Technology classes.
- **Hair** must be kept tidy and out of students' faces. Hair is not required to be tied up UNLESS it is for school photographs/sports photographs/any subject that requires it to be tied up for health and safety reasons/school prizegivings/representing the school. Extreme hair styles are not acceptable.
- **Make-up** (if worn) should be natural-looking.
- **All students** are required to be clean-shaven.
- **Taonga or cultural or religious** necklaces or neckpieces are able to be worn.
- **Up to three** small plain stud earrings or sleepers can be worn in each ear – dangling earrings are not allowed.
- **Visible facial piercings/nose studs/nose rings** are not allowed.
- **Non-uniform items** worn at school need to be handed into the Deans' House and collected by students after school on Fridays. We have a limited supply of uniform items in the Deans' House which we lend to students on a daily or medium-term basis until the uniform issue is fully resolved.

Any concerns related to uniform and personal presentation will initially be followed up by the House Form Teacher and subject teachers. The concerns may then be referred to the relevant House Deans and House Senior Leadership Team member.


