- 1. Using the included template, mark and cut an opening in the ceiling.



2. Remove junction box knock-outs for wiring and open the junction box.

NOTE: The junction box contains three wires: Hot (BLACK), Neutral (WHITE), and Ground (GREEN).

- 3. Connect supply wires to junction box wires (GREEN to GREEN, BLACK to BLACK, WHITE to WHITE).
- 4. Connect downlight to junction box with the quick-connect cable. Select the color temperature (CCT) using the 5CCT switch on the junction box. Then, place the junction box into the ceiling.

5. Push "Easy Mount" clips on the luminaire.



6. Insert downlight into the ceiling and release clips to secure the downlight in the ceiling.



- 7. The New Construction Plate can be used to provide extra support for a variety of sizes (4, 6 and 8 inch). Select the luminaire hole size by matching the luminaire to the rings on the frame kit and select the ring that is slightly smaller than the outer diameter of the fixture.
- 8. Using a pair of cutters, cut the ring out that corresponds to the luminaire being installed. Lay the frame kit on the ceiling joist in the desired location and secure to joists.

NOTE: Allow enough space for the Junction Box mounted on the Mounting Plate
