



This product and its use conforms to CSA Z11-12 Portable Ladders.

NOTICE:

A Stepladder is a self-supporting portable ladder, non-adjustable in length, having flat steps and hinged back. The back section consists of either a single ladder or some other supporting device.

This product can be used with planks in a Ladder Type Scaffold (ANSI 10.8 Section 17) setup.

Selection:

- DANGER! Do not use this product in the vicinity of live electrical wires.
- The duty rating of this ladder is 300 lbs.
- 3) Select equipment of proper length to reach working height.

Inspection:

- 1) Inspect ladder upon receipt and before each use.
- 2) Make sure all rivets and joints, nuts and bolts are tight and secure.
- 3) Never use a damaged, bent or broken ladder.
- 4) Never make temporary repairs of damaged or missing parts.
- 5) All parts must be in good working order.

Proper Setup:

- 1) Do not set up this product in the vicinity of live electrical wires.
- Place ladder on a firm and level surface. Do not place on a slippery or uneven surface.
- Open ladder and ensure that the spreaders are fully open and in the locked position. Do not use a ladder in a partially closed position.
- Do not place ladder in front of doors that can open toward the ladder.

Proper Climbing and Use:

- Do not use a ladder if you tire easily, are subject to fainting spells, are using medicine or alcohol, or are physically handicapped.
- 2) To protect children, do not leave a ladder setup and unattended.
- 3) Do not stand on the ladder top cap or the first step down from the top.
- Portable ladders are not designed for excessive side loading. Do not overreach. Keep belt buckle between side rails.
- 5) When ascending of descending the ladder, the user shall face the ladder, maintain 3-points of contact and keep a firm grip on the ladder.
