- Winemaker: Charles Smith
- Known For: Golden West fulfills the promise of what they set out to do: to bring really great wine to a lot more people.
- The Wine: Vintage leather, cedar, anise and wild strawberry on the nose. The body is layered with pipe tobacco, morels and pie crust that come across the palate pure and full. Focused as it journeys to a seamless, endless crescendo.

- Winemaker: Kate Michaud
- Known For: A focus on Cabernet Sauvignon from Washington State's best appellations.
- The Wine: Blackberry, plum and floral notes on the nose with flavors of cherry, blueberry and minerality on the palate. A full and rich texture, finishing with a juicy acidity that is characteristic of Horse Heaven Hills.

INTRINSIC

- Winemaker: Juan Muñoz Oca
- Known For: Exploring the raw, yet elegant characteristics of Cabernet Sauvignon in Washington and establishing new, cutting edge techniques for winemaking.
- The Wine: Refined notes of raspberry, white tea leaves, and a hint of fresh mint with layered flavors of milk chocolate, dark plum and licorice root. The texture is angular, yet sophisticated, with chocolate ganache details in the finish.
