## Frog's Leap, Grgich Hills, & Tablas Creek



**Frog's Leap Napa Valley  
Sauvignon Blanc**

Made entirely from dry-farmed and certified organically grown grapes, the Frog's Leap Sauvignon Blanc is farmed and vinified in such a way as to retain the purity and distinctiveness of this noble variety – Frog's Leap keeps the alcohol low, the acidity high, and the flavors crisp, refreshing and complex. This wine is lovely, with stone fruit, crisp green apple, and wonderfully bright mineral flavors.



**Grgich Hills Estate  
Chardonnay**

Miljenko "Mike" Grgich has been called "The King of Chardonnay" since the Paris Tasting of 1976, and you can taste why in this classically-styled wine. This Chardonnay does not undergo malo-lactic fermentation, preserving its natural acidity. This balanced and complex wine displays crisp Fuji apple, stone fruit, citrus flower and a hint of minerality, progressing seamlessly to a long, elegant and harmonious finish.



**Tablas Creek  
Cotes de Tablas Blanc**

Tablas Creek is a pioneer of California's Rhone movement. It is the culmination of a friendship between two of the international wine community's leading families: the Perrin family of Chateau de Beaucastel and the Haas family of Vineyard Brands. This wine has an elegant nose of apricots cut with lemon, Asian spices, and crushed rock. A clean, fresh, and elegant finish rounds out the wine, leaving a lingering impression of sea spray minerality.
