

Made entirely from dry-farmed and certified organically grown grapes, the Frog's Leap Sauvignon Blanc is farmed and vinified in such a way as to retain the purity and distinctiveness of this noble variety – Frog's Leap keeps the alcohol low, the acidity high, and the flavors crisp, refreshing and complex. This wine is lovely, with stone fruit, crisp green apple, and wonderfully bright mineral flavors. Miljenko "Mike" Grgich has been called "The King of Chardonnay" since the Paris Tasting of 1976, and you can taste why in this classically-styled wine. This Chardonnay does not undergo malolactic fermentation, preserving its natural acidity. This balanced and complex wine displays crisp Fuji apple, stone fruit, citrus flower and a hint of minerality, progressing seamlessly to a long, elegant and harmonious finish. Tablas Creek is a pioneer of California's Rhone movement. It is the culmination of a friendship between two of the international wine community's leading families: the Perrin family of Chateau de Beaucastel and the Haas family of Vineyard Brands. This wine has an elegant nose of apricots cut with lemon, Asian spices, and crushed rock. A clean, fresh, and elegant finish rounds out the wine, leaving a lingering impression of sea spray minerality.
