The vines of the Barbera, Plana and Viader plots have deep soil with a clay loam texture, which provides us with freshness and elegance. The Monastrell plot, situated on the terraces on Serral hill, marks the De Nit sparkling wine with its personality. The Latin word "Ultreia" was used to greet the pilgrims of the Camino de Santiago, a word that means "forward", and, in this way, Raúl Pérez named one of his most well-known and appreciated wine collections. Floral, spicy aromas with hints of underbrush. Juicy, wellstructured red fruit with great vibrancy, and a long finish marked by hints of herbs, coffee bean, and tomato leaf. Affordably priced, Camins del Priorat stays true to Palacio's vision of Priorat powerful but elegant, approachable but restrained. Blend: 40% Garnacha, 30% Cinsault, 20% Cabernet Sauvignon, 10% Syrah.
