

<p>RHYTHM Refers to combinations of long and short sounds, and silences.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Do you hear the same long and short patterns throughout? 2. Do you hear different long and short patterns throughout? 3. Can you clap a rhythm from the music? 4. Can you notate this rhythm? 	<p>TEMPO Refers to the <i>speed</i> of the music.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Is the music fast, slow or moderate? 2. Does the music stay the same speed throughout?
<p>TONE COLOUR Refers to the special quality of sound that distinguishes one section of the orchestra from another</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Which instruments can you identify? 2. How would you describe their sounds? 3. Do you hear the same instruments throughout the music or do the instruments change? 	<p>MELODY Refers to arrangement of pitches (high, middle and low sounds)</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Is the music low, high, or changing throughout? 2. Describe the pitch from the beginning of the music through to the end of the music.
<p>ELEMENT CARDS</p>	<p>DYNAMICS Refers to how <i>loud</i> or <i>soft</i> the music is</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Is the music loud, quiet or changing throughout? 2. Describe the dynamics from the beginning of the music through to the end of the music.
