Edmonton, AB (July 24, 2023) – The Edmonton Symphony Orchestra (ESO) are on the move this summer with ESO Outdoors. Presented by Qualico Communties, audiences are invited to join members of your ESO for pay-what-you-can performances around Alberta, and in your neighbourhood, this August!

From August 17 to 27, curated groups of ESO musicians, conducted by ESO Resident Conductor Cosette Justo Valdés, will perform a variety of music to delight and entertain audiences. These concerts will take place in outdoor spaces in Edmonton and surrounding communities including Beaumont, Fort Saskatchewan, Stony Plain, and Devon. Each concert is general admission, approximately one hour in length, and bring your own seating. Audiences have a chance to experience renditions of memorable works spanning multiple genres, including classical, pops, and Hollywood films.

The programming varies for each ESO Outdoors performance. You'll hear everything from music by Handel, Mozart, and Vivaldi to Prokofiev's *Peter and the Wolf* and Ian Tyson's *Four Strong Winds*. ESO soloists, including ESO Concertmaster Robert Uchida (Violin), will be featured in each performance.

"It's exciting to offer a beautiful opportunity for communities to come together again. Each special outdoor performance will offer joy and a human connection through live music," says Annemarie Petrov, President and CEO of the Winspear Centre and Edmonton Symphony Orchestra.

ESO Outdoors started during the summer of 2021 as a way for the Edmonton Symphony Orchestra musicians to perform safely for small audiences and bring the magic of live music into their own neighbourhoods.
