Phander Valley, nestled in Gilgit-Baltistan's Ghizer District, captivates visitors with its natural allure. Situated northwest of Gilgit City, it offers cozy lodging along the Gilgit-Chital road. Known as "Little Kashmir," its stunning landscapes, lush farms, azure lakes, and meandering river, famed for trout, enchant all who visit. Orchards and verdant fields line the Gilgit River's path, providing a serene atmosphere. The region boasts four sizable lakes, with Phander Lake as the largest. The Gilgit River, splitting into rivulets upon entering the valley, reunites upon departure. Notable accommodations include the Wali Hotel and Shandur Guest House. The best time to visit is June and July, when the weather is ideal. A visit to Shandur Pass, Shandur Lake, and Shandur Polo Ground is a must, just three hours from Phander.

PLACES TO VISIT

Phandar Lake:

Phander Lake is a beautiful lake located in Phander Valley. Blue water, brown mountains, and some green region surrounding the fresh water. Lake is fed by the Gilgit River and the lake has crystal clear water. The lake has beautiful sunrise and sunset scenes.



Shandur Pass:

High-altitude Shandur Pass connects Phander Valley with Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, a region Chitral. A few hours away from Phander lays the well-known Shandur Pass, which is more natural and remote.



Shandur Lake:

Shandur Lake is located near to Shandur Pass. One of Pakistan's most exquisite lakes is Shandur Lake. Shandur Lake's upper surface is so level that it is also referred to as the "Roof of the World." Shandur Lake is breathtakingly beautiful. If you visit Shandur pass then you should visit Shandur lake.



Yasin Valley

Situated in the northwest of Gilgit, in the Northern Areas of Pakistan, the Yasin Valley is a high alpine valley surrounded by the Hindu Kush mountains. A tall mountain pass divides Yasin from the Ishkoman Valley. If you are visiting Phander Valley then you can visit Yasin Valley also. The best time to visit Yasin Valley is from May to September. The valley shows vibrant colors in spring and autumn. Tourists love to see the unmatchable colors of nature at this time.



Khalti Lake

Khalti Lake which is situated in Khalti Village of Gupis-Yasin District Gilgit-Baltistan. In the Khalti hamlet in Phander Valley, Khalti Lake is a hidden gem. The lake is well-known for both its gorgeous waters and its amazing views of the mountains in the area.



Ghizer River

Ghizer Valley is the most beautiful valley in Gilgit Baltistan which is at distance of 2 and half hours from Phander valley. Ghizer is also the point of contact between Gilgit and Chitral through the Shandur Pass. The River is additionally known as the Gilgit River as well.



Teru

Slightly higher up in the mountains than Phander is Teru, another lovely settlement. Its pastures and modest homes are great for a day's roaming.



Rainbow Mountain

There are several villages in Yasin Valley, all of them are surrounded by tall mountain ranges. Recently, Rainbow peak, a magnificently coloured peak, was discovered in a valley called Qorqulti that borders other parts of Gilgit Baltistan, primarily the meadows of Chatorkhand. A rainbow mountain resembles the seven colours of a rainbow; due to this, it is called a rainbow mountain. You should visit this beautiful mountain if visit Gilgit region.



The Rover by Roomy Phander

Nestled within the stunning Phander Valley, The Rover by Roomy promises an escape into the heart of nature. Cozy cabins and huts overlook the snow-capped Hindukush mountains, while a gently flowing river weaves its way through the landscape.
