



ABOUT FAIRY MEADOWS

Fairy Meadows is a treat for nature lovers, photographers, trekkers, and people who seek peace. Fairy Meadows is called as "Heaven on Earth". A grassland next to one of the Nanga Parbat base camp locations, Fairy Meadows (German: Märchenwiese, "fairy tale meadows") is called by German climbers and locally referred to as Joot. It is situated in the Diamer District of Gilgit-Baltistan, Pakistan. The heart of Gilgit Baltistan is Fairy Meadow. The center of North Pakistan, Fairy Meadows is well-known for its breathtaking, lush green mountains and Nanga Parbat, the world's ninth-biggest peak. The settlement of Tattu (Tato) is the beginning point for a fifteen-kilometer jeepable walk that leads to Fairy Meadows from the Karakoram Highway's Raikot Bridge.

Day 1

- 1 Departure for Fairy Meadows from Islamabad:
 - · Start journey from Islamabad to chillas.
 - · Short stay at Kiwai/Balakot.
 - · Visit Lulusar Lake and Babusar Top.
 - · Continue to drive towards Chillas.
 - · Dinner and night stay at Chillas.

Day 2

- 2 Explore Kumrat Waterfall and Jahaz Banda
 - Breakfast.
 - Departure for Raikot .
 - Transfer to jeeps from Raikot to Tatu Village.
 - 4 to 5 hours of trekking till Fairy Meadows.
 - · Arrival at Fairy Meadows in the evening.
 - · Dinner and night stay at Fairy Meadows

Day 3

- 3 Trekking towards Beyal Camp:
 - · Breakfast.
 - Start trekking towards Beyal Camp and Nanga Parbat View Point.
 - Visit Surroundings.
 - Return back to Fairy Meadows.
 - Dinner and night stay at Fairy Meadows

Day 4

- 4 Departure for Naran:
 - · Breakfast .
 - Start descending to Tatu Village.
 - Departure for Raikot on jeeps.
 - Departure for Naran.
 - Dinner and night stay in Naran.

Day 4

- **5** Departure back to Islamabad:
 - Breakfast .
 - Departure for Islamabad.
 - Short stays at Kiwai, Balakot on the way back to Islamabad.

PLACES TO VISIT

Rikot Bridge:

The Raikot Bridge is a road bridge that crosses the River Indus and is located on the Karakoram Highway. In the Diamer District of Gilgit Baltistan, Pakistan, it serves as the entrance to the Nanga Parbat base camp. It is essential for maintaining connections between the isolated regions of northern Pakistan and for making it easier for people and products to move between the two provinces Gilgit-Baltistan and Khyber Pakhtunkhwa.



Nanga Parbat:

In Gilgit-Baltistan, Nanga Parbat is a mountain situated between Chilas and Astore. It is the world's ninth-highest peak. It is situated 26,660 feet (8,126 meters) above sea level. Nanga Parbat means "Naked Mountain".Nanga Parbat is the second highest mountain of Pakistan and ninth highest in the world..



Rama Lake:

Rama Lake, also known as راما سر جهيل, is a lake in Gilgit-Baltistan, Pakistan, that is close to Astore. Rama Lake is located in the foot hills of Nanga Parbat massif and just below the Rama Glacier. There is a steep 4x4 mud route leading to this lake. A few of glaciers are in the path. The lake and the views all around it are breathtaking, especially the one overlooking Nanga Parbat.



Beyal Camp:

The Beyal camp is a small camping spot that is located a few kilometers from Fairy Meadows. Beyal Camp offers an interesting and daring camping experience. Beyal Camp's major attractions include a little stream, snow-capped mountains, rich green trees, and a lovely grassy carpet.



Raikot Sarai:

At the summit of Fairy Meadows lies a resort camp called Raikot Sarai. The Raikot glacier is seen from the Raikot Sarai cottages. To go to Tatoo village, hire a vehicle from Raikot Sarai. It takes two to three hours of walking from Tatoo village to Fairy Meadows. Raikot Sarai camping is the most enjoyable and unforgettable experience of your life.



Raikot Sarai Hotel:

It's the most beautiful and well organised resort. The rooms are nice and the staff is very friendly. The resort is quite picturesque; the forest, trees, and river vista all give you a sense of being extremely near to nature.









Northern Retreat:

One kilometre before Naran, in the Naran Valley, is the 4**** Northern Retreat Naran hotel. With a terrace, Northern Retreat Naran offers a hill station experience in Naran. Hotel that features a restaurant, a terrace, private balconies, free parking, and a la carte breakfast.









Shangrila Chilas Hotel:

The Shangrila Chilas Hotel is located in Chilas. The Shangri-La Hotel Chilas has up to 100 roomy, distinctively furnished rooms with opulent facilities. Every one of these rooms has a nice night's sleep with a view of the Indus River.









Trout Fish:



Fish like trout is frequently eaten with vegetables and rice or roti. The delicate flavour and juicy, soft meat of the fish make for a delightful and filling supper. If you love seafood, you have to taste it when you visit the Naran Kaghan Valley.

Karahi:



Karahi is another typical cuisine from the Naran Kaghan Valley. This well-known meal is created with chicken or lamb that has been cooked in a wok-like pot called a "karahi" with a variety of spices. It is a mainstay in many local homes and is usually eaten with rice or roti.


Chapli Kabab:


