

# **HPV COLLECTION KIT**

A vaginal swab sample collection kit used for the collection and transportation of samples for laboratory analysis of Human Papilloma Virus (HPV) by nucleic acid technique (NAT)

This kit contains the materials required for either sample self-collection or collection by a health/social care professional.

## Sample collection instructions (Steps 1-12)

- Please ensure the kit is within expiry date and read these instructions carefully and completely before attempting to collect the sample.
- If your kit requires online activation, please follow the instructions provided by your healthcare organisation. If you need assistance please contact the healthcare organisation who arranged the test.
- . The white tip of the wand must be in place and not be bent or removed before self-sampling.
- Ensure the wand is held straight when inserting it in and taking it out of your vagina. You can take your test in a standing or lying position.
- Do not collect a sample during menstruation (your period). Sampling can be carried out during the first three months of pregnancy.



## **SELF-COLLECTION HPV SAMPLE**





Clearly complete the sample collection tube label using a ball point pen with:

- Your First name
- Your Surname
- Your Date of birth
- Sample type: HPV Do not affix it to the tube at this stage.




Wash your hands in warm soapy water.






Keep the wand straight while collecting your sample. Insert the wand into your vagina as shown.



Rotate the self-sampling wand once. Take the wand out (keeping it straight).






Unscrew the lid of the sample tube. Put the white portion of the wand into the sample tube. Bend the wand so that the white section falls into the sample tube. Screw the lid back onto the sample tube and dispose of the blue portion of the wand.

Affix the label by placing the sample tube in the middle of the label and wrapping the label around the shaft as shown below.





Please make a note of the unique tracking number displayed under the barcode on the postal tracking label, as shown below. Keep this in a safe place for future reference. ### 12 IMPORTANT CHECKLIST

Before you return your sample please do the following:

- Place your completed request form supplied by your doctor/clinic into the postal envelope
- Make sure that the sample tube is labelled and has been placed inside the protective packing case
- Place the packing case into the collection kit outer box
- Close the collection kit outer box firmly and apply the return security label to seal it
- Place the collection kit outer box into the return postal envelope
  - Check that you have taken note of your postal tracking number

You are now ready to seal the postal envelope. Please store at room temperature until posted.

Please post your sample to The Doctors Laboratory as soon as possible (ideally on same day or within 24 hours of sample collection) from ANY Royal Mail post box in the UK. No stamp is required within the UK.

- This kit is designed for use by persons aged 18 and over and upon request of a healthcare professional or healthcare organisation.
- The kit should not be used by individuals lacking the physical or mental capacity to correctly follow the self-collection instructions. If you have problems please consult with your advising healthcare professional.
- Do not collect a sample during menstruation (your period).
- Sampling can be carried out during the first three months of pregnancy.
- It is advisable to refrain from intercourse and the use of vaginal creams, gels and tablets for 48 hours prior to sampling.
- This kit is not suitable for collecting alternative sample types or for the collection and transport of viruses or other microorganisms, other than those which have been verified by the testing laboratory
- Samples arriving at the laboratory which show evidence of the below may not be tested:
  - · No white wand end inside the collection tube
  - Different swab type/brand to the one supplied
  - · General damage
- Use with caution if allergic to nylon fibre and ABS (Acrylonitrile butadiene styrene) material. If any problems arise during the sample collection process please contact your healthcare organisation.
- The accuracy of your results may be compromised if you do not read and follow the instructions in full.
- Samples arriving at the laboratory which show signs of degradation or general damage or arrive after 6 days of sample taking may not
- This collection kit is for HPV ONLY and not suitable for collecting cells for cervical cytology (microscopic) assessment.
